

PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy sets out how Bread Birmingham uses and protects your `personal information / data` – any information that you give us when you sign or subscribe for specific information.

Protecting your data and privacy is important to us. Any data we collect will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

We may collect the following information:

- name and job title
- contact information including email address
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers

WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION WE GATHER?

We ask for your information for the following reasons...

- Internal record keeping – CV's, application forms etc.
- Newsletters. If you register for our newsletter than we hold and store your email address using Mailchimp (our email service provider) we may then send promotional emails about special offers or other marketing information using the email you provided. When you register for our newsletter you can also opt in or opt out to receive customised online advertising.
- From time to time, we may also hold your information on your request i.e. credit card details.
- We may also contact you by email, phone, fax or mail. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.

SECURITY

We are committed to ensuring your information is secure. We have put in place across our business suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to help safeguard and secure the information we collect online. HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file sent by our web server to your web browser, this enables web applications to respond to you as an individual. We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us tailor our website to your needs.
